





# Press Release.



The Roma Clay Target Club in conjunction with the Armstrong Auto Group is promoting major events over a 3 year period to try and re-introduce a series of car shoots to our sport. A format was devised and tried in March 2018, and March 2019 with great success, and the Mitsubishi Triton being won by Byron Hewitt off of 24m in 2018, and 12 year old Chloe Evans in 2019 off of 15m.

The format provides for the conduct of a normal shoot program with all prizes as would be expected (with a higher value than normal) but with an increase in nomination cost to allow 40 qualifying from the shoot to contest the Mitsubishi Twin Cab 4x4 in a Handicap shoot-off.

Further, a second small car will be drawn as a lucky door prize from all entrants who enter the whole program, the 2018 prize was won by Terry Morony from Gold Coast Clay Target Club, and the 2019 prize was won by Robert Hunter from Townsville Gun Club.

This format could be adopted by any club with enough traps to contest the event and car shoots could once again become a regular feature in our sport.

To create greater interest, a number of spots for the final will be auctioned. These spots may be bought by individuals or syndicates who can then nominate their shooter who must have entered all 6 events.

However, to ensure that the final is a tense and exciting spectacle worthy of the prize value, it has been decided that once the 40 spots are filled any of the qualifiers colluding to split the car prior to the shoot – offs completion will not be permitted to enter subsequent car shoot events at this club.

There is no smoke and mirrors here and both cars will be awarded on the day. The club has taken a large gamble by committing to a 3 year trial.

All we ask is that shooters who wish to see the profile of our sport lifted come along, have a great time and be part of what can be the most exciting development in competition in our sport for decades.
